From her mother - who would now be aged about 100 were she still alive - Mrs Fisher had heard of "Bobby Miller's dancing classes" in Penrith. Her mother had been to these classes, and had learnt there the Square-8 and Long-8.

Mrs Fisher also showed me a cutting from The Cumberland News for 1/1/60, which contained an account of an estate dance at Eden Hall in 1854. Her great-grandfather was one of the fiddlers, and dances mentioned were Triumph and Spanish Waltz. The original should be of interest.
