

Mr Thomas Jackson, Post Office, High Newton (in Carmel), N. Wales, aged 88

A rather hurried interview, since he was at lunch and we were on our way home.

Mr Jackson has danced Greensleeves in his youth, and remembers it quite well. There was first a circle facing inwards, then a circle back to back, then finally the clap, bat, and kick, done while circling round two or three times, then repeated while they go round in the opposite direction. He had no memory of hopping on one leg.

It is quite 70 years since it was done in High Newton, <sup>itself</sup> and before that was done just at an ordinary "periodical dance". Just some of the older people did it.

He has never heard of a broomstick dance.
