The spinning is now in good order, fly repaired, new pins, all scrubbed and spinning away. My first two ply wool is almost as bad as the hand spun stuff - I shall use it all for weaving! I shall go out as soon as the shops open to get some raw linseed oil to rub into the spinning to finish it.

Thanks for putting me up <sup>Frida</sup> Saturday night. I always enjoy staying with you. I'll let you know when I am coming up to Liverpool again. It won't be very soon for I cleared up most of the problems with Arthur on Saturday.

I enclose some <sup>receipts</sup> which you will want. Let me have the details of our expenses when you have them ready.
