This is just a note to accompany two presents from Twhey. The spridle come from a bayacer in Bursa - we bought it from the actual turner.

The last six weeks of ow visit were very succentral - we managed to have a car (into drive) as we went south, north, a east of Anhare. The first trip was through Konya, over the Tawas mountains to Silette, then along the count to Mersin at back over the Tawas mountains on the Adams - Anhare road. Superb country both ways, with natural rock gardens in the Tawas mountains (at places the road was at about 5000 ft). Second trip was north to Amarra on the Black See count (a incidentally, at Bartin we found a Turner who makes spinning whele complete). The valley for Georede to Device is another lovely patch the nicest we saw in Tushey—and is carpeted with inld flower, builds, orchido, and alphase. Third trip was to Kayser a back via Urgub and Gorene, rather dull country, but exerting for the buildings.

In the end we brought back some 7 dozen bulbs (including 2 doze grape hydrenths brought for sentimental reasons) and several dozen plants, mostly unidentified alpines. I don't know (or howen't been able to find out) what an Evenium is, so don't know it we have one. I have built a scree in the rock garder (on the horizontal) to give good dramage, a hope at least some will live.

Should you be north before you go to the States we would be delighted to see you the hope you enjoy you visit, and I'll keep my fright crossed for your mathematics.
